Eligibility

- •All pre-K 12th grade students from all U.S. states and territories are welcome to submit artwork.
- •Public, private, charter and home schools are eligible to participate.
- •One entry per student.

Description

Artwork should illustrate the general theme of how zero waste on land helps to protect the health of our local watersheds and ocean.

Criteria for Art

- •Each entry must be on a single sheet of paper no bigger than 11"x14".
- •Any art medium may be used.
- •Artwork must be hand-drawn by the student.
- •No brand names should be included in the artwork.
- •Label each entry on the back in pencil with the student's name, grade, teacher's name, school name, address, and telephone number
- •Student will be notified if their artwork is selected.
