 Depth: 10-1,250 meters Multiple colors (primarily yellow/brown) Size: Up to 1 meter, but most are much smaller Can be found attached to rock for filter feeding or free swimming 	 Depth: 4-110 meters Primarily pink/purple Size: Maximum 30 centimeters in height and 60 centimeters in width Adheres to rocky substrate and thrives in high current areas 	 Depth: 30-120 meters Orange to pink in color with purple edges around white spots Size: 10-25 centimeters 	 Depth: 250-800 meters White in color Size: 15-25 centimeters
