


...and cooler, more stable oceans are better for humpback whales!



Why are more stable ocean temperatures good for whales?

- **Humpback whales feed on smaller animals called krill.**
- **Changing ocean temperatures cause krill to move to cooler waters that they find more comfortable.**
- **Moving krill populations may contribute to a shift in humpback whale migration patterns. This means that humpback whales could be forced to migrate earlier and travel farther in search of food.**
